I am writing to you regarding a fantastic event that we are holding for some of our students on Tuesday 16th November.

A Georgian singing and dancing group called “Shavnabada” are visiting the UK on a tour to promote the culture, music and dance of their country. I am delighted that as part of this tour, they will be holding workshop events on Tuesday 16th November for Music, Dance and English students. This will give students an opportunity to watch performances of singing and dancing and to take part in specialist workshops.

The students that are invited to take part in this event will miss their normal timetabled lessons for most of this day, but it is a real chance to make International links and to work with professional musicians/dancers. Please could you give your consent for your child’s involvement at this event by filling in the form at the bottom of the sheet and returning it to Ms. M. Colvill (musicians) or Miss. J. Kirk (dancers) or Miss L. Horsfall (reporters/media students).

If your child is involved musically in this event, they **must** be committed to performing with “Shavnabada” at Wakefield Cathedral on Friday 19th November. Students will be expected to make their own way to the rehearsal and parents should pick them up after the concert in the evening. This concert begins at 7.30p.m. but students will need to be there earlier for a rehearsal. Tickets are available on the door at a cost of 12/10. I will write to you at a later date confirming the time of the rehearsal at the cathedral. It is important that you complete a further consent form for this trip so that we have contact details for every child in case of an emergency.
